The meeting was called to order by Linda Powers at 3:00.

Attending were: Linda Powers, Ruth Heinzelemann, Lynn Brammer, Sam Hicks and Linda Spivey

A motion to approve the Agenda was made and passed.

Minutes of the July meeting were passed with the addition that all current officers have agreed to serve in the same positions next year.

Sam presented the Treasurer's report. We have total assets of \$37,276.36: \$25,762.80 in checking, 2 CDs at \$5,798.10 and \$5,715.46.

Ruth announced that the American Red Cross will be having a blood drive on Saturday September 10 (9 a.m. to 2 p.m.) at the Waldron Wellness Center. Co-sponsors are Blue Church and the Montgomery Floyd Regional Library. If patrons of the Montgomery Floyd Regional Library have fines and donate blood we will forgive up to \$10 - only redeemable at Meadowbrook Public Library. Donors will also be able to select a used library book to take home, compliments of Meadowbrook Library.

Because Sam had to leave early, there were only 3 members at the meeting. We tabled the agenda items on fundraising, changes for the newsletter, and changing our membership software until more members could be present.

We voted to support the Virginia Tech Dining Services Customer Appreciation Dinner with the provisions that only children's books be donated, that Lynn contact each of the 3 library branches supervisors to see if there are any concerns, and that she meet with the Food Production Manager who sent the email to see what is required of the Friends.

Lastly, Ruth mentioned upcoming Meadowbrook events and book sales: The Tomato Festival, the Harvest Festival and a bag book sale in November. She also reported that the Meadowbrook Back Pack program, which supplied book bags, school supplies, books and food, served 120 children. It was a very successful event.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:50 .
